



## Sport Premium Funding 2015/2016

### The Academy and Local Improvement Board vision

At Carrfield Primary Academy the total Sport Premium funding will amount to £9,500. The staff and governing body share a vision for the long term development of PE and support at the Academy so that the additional funding will have:

- *A long lasting and positive impact on the future learning and physical development of children.*
- *Staff will have greater confidence in delivering physical education to all pupils.*
- *The Academy will have developed links with schools, clubs, associations and agencies that promote sport and healthy lifestyles both within and beyond the local community.*

- *Provide CPD opportunities for all staff.*
- *Offer pupils the opportunity to engage in high quality after school sports clubs.*
- *Offer pupils the opportunity to take part in sporting competitions both within the academy and between other schools.*

- *Engage with parents to increase participation of pupils with sport and sporting opportunities.*
- *Raise the profile of PE and sport across school to create a sporting legacy for the Academy and the community to be proud of.*
- *Raise the profile of PE and sport across school as a tool for whole school improvement.*
