## Use of sunscreen in school

The school would like to help support the concern of sunburn and skin damage that is caused by harmful ultra-violet rays of sunlight. We will be encouraging children to avoid sunburn and over exposure of the sun by:

- Seeking the shade, particularly during the middle of the day
- Wearing suitable hats
- Wearing clothing that protects the skin, particularly for outdoor activities and school trips
- Using a high factor of sunscreen (SPF 15+)

Sunscreens provide added protection and may be useful when other measures are not available. Dermatologists recommend that a sunscreen with a protection factor of SPF 15 or above will provide children in this country with adequate protection. The school requests that parent/carers provide sunscreen for this purpose. Most children will be able, with some direction, to apply sunscreens themselves. However young children or those with special educational needs may require some help. Staff will often assist children on a voluntary basis.

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## School Visit Annual Consent

Throughout the year the school organises a number of routine visits and journeys away from the school site as part of the children's learning experiences. Such visits take place during the school session times and tend to be local within the local area.

Routine visits and journeys during the school day are an extension to their classroom activities and present no significant risk to health and safety of pupils.

All visits and journeys away from the school site must be approved by the Principal.

The purpose of this consent form is to enable parents/guardians of children at the school to give permission for their child to participate in visits and journeys away from the school during the school day.

This consent will allow your child to leave the school site for a local visit on several occasions without having to sign a separate consent form for each visit.

### Examples of such visits are:

- Local sporting fixture, Local school visits and visits to local amenities.
